Consideration of the Order will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at Hemyock Village Hall, Culmbridge Road, Hemyock, Devon, EX15 3QW on **Tuesday 8 December 2015** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by **ADDING** Footpath No.2, Culmstock (part) and Bridleway No. 38, Culmstock and Restricted Byway No. 1, Hemyock and **UPGRADING** Footpath No. 2 Culmstock (part) to Bridleway No. 38 Culmstock.

Footpath No. 2 Culmstock (part) starts at the county road at Pitt Farm Culmstock and proceeds south eastwards along the farm track then north through a field gate and continues as Footpath No. 2, Culmstock to the Hemyock parish boundary.

Bridleway No. 38, Culmstock starts at the county road at Pitt Farm Culmstock and proceeds in an east south easterly direction along a farm track and continues through a hedged lane to the Culmstock/Hemyock parish boundary to join Restricted Byway No. 1, Hemyock.

Restricted Byway No. 1 Hemyock starts at the Culmstock/Hemyock parish boundary and continues south easterly through a predominantly hedged lane to join the county road south of Clements Farm Hemyock.
