Hemyock Parish Council.

Items still with Devon County Council Highways.

- The road sign at the entrance east of the top of Lewis Hill
- The village sign at the north end of Spynedonburgh
- The wooden signs at the end of the Alcock Road in Spynedonburgh
- The Stop Left sign on Longwood in Hill Street.
- The Bollington road sign in village
- The Bollington Stop sign on White Lane in Hill Street
- The white Stop sign between Station Road and Hemyock Road has not been replaced
- The parking sign on Station Road and elsewhere are still there.
- The priority sign at the entrance going up Station Road is still missing.
- The footpath at Millhouse Lane is still too wide for cars here and PTV access up Parsons Hill
- The pavement up Station Hill from the top has not yet been built.
- The air railings over the footpath is still there.
- The Culverston direction sign outside St Mary's is still missing.

To do the rest of these items before July 2010.
