Hemyock Parish Council - Public Question Time

- 1) A parishioner from Churchills made the following observations:
 - There are 2 garages empty at Churchills – why are they not being let out?
 - The grass around Churchills was cut twice in March by the District Council and they left it in a mess.
 - Dog mess everywhere
 - Problem in the area with anti-social behaviour.

- 2) A parishioner asked what was happening about the allotments; Mrs.Stallard said it would come up in the main meeting under “Matters Arising”.

- 3) Mr.D. Gubb asked about the hole by Millhayes Bridge – how much longer is it going to be there? Mrs.Stallard several services are involved with this matter.

- 4) Mr.D. Gubb also reported potholes by the telephone exchange.

- 5) AVM Attlee reported that there had been vandalism at the Church recently and vandalism to two cars.

- 6) Mr.I.Pike asked what was happening about the old tennis courts – could they be used for more parking spaces. Mrs.Stallard said access would be difficult and visibility would be an issue.

- 7) Mr.G.Pike said that the area in Longmead to the north of the sewage works would be an ideal place for the allotments; AVM Attlee said parking could be difficult on a Saturday when football matches are taking place.

- 8) Mr.A.Smith said he also thought the old tennis courts would be good for additional parking.

- 9) Mr.D.Gubb asked if anyone knew what the black boxes were that had appeared on several poles around the village; they have now been taken away again; no one knew what they were.
