PROPOSAL: The Council is unable to support the application as it has been unable to visit the site. A request for a site visit had been declined. PROPOSED: Mr Major SECONDED: Mr Hart DECISION: passed. (5 in favour) Mr Clist and Mr Povah felt that this proposal was too strongly worded and suggested it might have said the council was unable to comment, due to site visit being declined. Mr Major explained that this would create a possible loophole whereby if an applicant felt the parish council would not be in support of an application, they could decline a site visit and yet secure a neutral comment from the parish council. Mr Povah suggested the plans and information supplied for the application did 	
 MDDC's Local Plan Review – Options Stage Consultation MDDC's Local Plan Review – Options Stage Consultation Mr Major gave a presentation on the above, summarising the document which includes the strategic options for the direction of future housing and employment growth in Mid Devon to cover the period 2013 to 2033. During 2013 a 'call for sites' was made by MDDC, inviting landowners to suggest sites that might have potential for development. The sites were assessed and all those considered technically achievable are included in the Local Plan Review. The sites included far exceed the amount of development that is likely to be allocated in the final version of the document and over the coming months MDDC will need to decide which overall strategy and which sites are most appropriate. 	
Within the plan 3 sites in Hemyock have been suggested by local landowners. Land South West of Conigar Close (35 houses), Culmbridge Farm (80 houses) and land North of Culmbridge Farm (80 houses). See attached map for more information.	
The consultation period runs until 24 th March and it is the prerogative of any parishioner to pass comment on the plan to MDDC.
