CLERK'S REPORT

Xmas Competition

I have mentioned the competition in the Pump, but need more information for noticeboards. When will judging take place? Who will judge? When and how will winners be notified?

TAP Fund

A meeting took place with representatives from Culmstock, Clayhidon and Hemyock Parish Councils.

Clayhidon Parish Council would like to use its allocated fund at Hidon Wood. Culmstock Parish Council would like to fund the Cricket Club and also create a pergola in the cemetery along with some new benches. Hemyock Parish Council would like to get the Garages Youth Project underway and need advice from a Youth Development Officer about costs and ideas. Mrs Stallard to confirm contact for Youth Development Officer. Mr Brooke to liaise with them to establish costs and potential ideas and then work with Clerk to complete draft application.

It was agreed that if the three councils applied for a joint grant covering these projects for the parishes then it may be more successful than 3 individual bids and more funds may be secured. It was agreed that these proposals had links that would benefit the three parishes. Hemyock Clerk will pull together the application with assistance from Culmstock & Clayhidon. Culmstock & Clayhidon to complete draft applications and cost the project and pass all necessary information back to Hemyock Clerk.

I have contacted Ray Radford to let him know of our intention to put in a joint application with Clayhidon & Culmstock and I also asked him about possible amounts that were available. He has confirmed that the only one not to put in a bid yet is Boredon Gate, which comprises of Clayhanger, Huntsham and Hockworthy Parishes their total comes to £413.60, but they may well put in an application for something. He also said that most parishes have put in applications for more than their allocations, and he has said to them, that he will agree to let them have up to their allocation. If there is any not spoken for, then they may have a bit more to share out, but that is looking very unlikely.

I am now waiting for Mr Brooke, Culmstock and Clayhidon to come back to me with information to enable me to complete the application.
