Public Question Time

1) Mr.Fred Salter reported that visibility is bad when trying to join Station Road from South View; cars park too near the entrance to South View and block the view. Mr.Salter said he was also representing Mr.T.Lowman, Mr.N.Hawkins, Mr.D.Bawler, Mr.A.Dyke, Mrs.Simmons, Mr.A.Bradbeer, Mr.S.Mathers and Mrs.Cleaves. Mr.Salter went on to say that he had spoken to Highways about the problem who said they could put in yellow lines; he had also spoken to Mr.Denham, Mr.W.Pike and Mr.Ray Radford about this matter.

Mr.Salter also reported that he had spoken to R.Upton regarding his hedge which he felt needed cutting back; Mr. Upton had said he couldn't see a problem with the hedge but Mr.Salter said that Mr.Hawkins, Mr.Dyke and Mrs.Simmons had all had near misses at this point and the hedge also impairs visibility when turning into South View. Mrs.Cartledge said that we have tried to avoid having yellow lines in the village. Mrs.Clist suggested that perhaps 6 feet of zig zag lines either side of the entrance might help.

- 2) Mr.F.Salter reported that the hedge by the bridge at Millhayes has grown up and made the visibility poor.
- 3) Mrs.Gubb said that the hedge by the street light by Culmbridge Farm needs to be cut back as it is obscuring the light.
