Public Question Time

- 1) Mr.Mike Eastick brought a picture that had been presented to the Upper Culm Twinning Association on their recent visit to France for the official twinning ceremony with an area in the Loire Valley called Jumelage des Grees. Mr.Eastick thanked Mrs.Stallard for going along and for presenting a plate given by the Parish Council. Mrs.Stallard had brought along a pitcher, 6 goblets and a tray which had been presented plus the English/French Charter. Mrs. Stallard said that the hospitality had been terrific; next year it all has to be gone through again when a party from the Loire Valley will visit Hemyock.
