 4. Update from Legal & Cavanna 4.1 Cavanna has asked who the £1,000 should be paid to as part of the 106 agreement. Clerk to advise the money should be paid to the parish council but to clarify when it should be paid as per 106 agreement. 	Clerk
4.2 Cavanna has confirmed that the transfer of the land has been delayed and is likely to be winter 2024. The clerk has asked Cavanna to clarify whether it intends to transfer the land at the beginning or the end of 2024.

It was agreed that it would be sensible to ask Cavanna to leave water and electric to site for future connection.	Clerk

Once the formal offer of the land has been made to the council, and the council accepts the offer, then there is a maximum period of 2 years in which the land has to be transferred. Once the offer has been made and accepted and the access resolved, the pc can promote the project and possibly attempt to secure the services (FOC) of a friendly architect/planner to assist with the design of the site.
